

ORDINANCE NO. L041101-01

ORDINANCE DESIGNATING HOOYMAN, HOUSE, LOWER, SPURR, AND BOELTER ROADS AS PERMANENT CLASS 'B'
WEIGHT LIMIT STATUS

Whereas, the Town of Liberty recognizes that unnecessary heavy traffic on Town roads drastically reduces the life of these roads and;
Whereas the Town of Liberty has an interest to move this traffic to roads created for the conveyance of heavy vehicular traffic and ;
Whereas the Town of Liberty is committed to keeping our road repair costs low:

Now Therefore the Town Board of Liberty, Outagamie County does ordain as follows:

1. ADOPTION

The Town Board of the Town of Liberty by this ordinance, designates the following roads in the Town of Liberty as "Class B" roads:

Hooyman Rd – Entire portion under control of the Town of Liberty

Lower Rd. – Entire portion under control of the Town of Liberty

Spurr Rd. – Entire portion under control of the Town of Liberty

Boelter Rd. – Entire portion under control of the Town of Liberty

House Rd. – Entire portion under control of the Town of Liberty

These roads shall be subject to weight limitations pursuant to Sec. 348.16, Wis. Stats.

2. PENALTY

Any person who shall violate any provision of this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof, forfeit not less than \$50.00 or more than \$100.00 together with the cost of prosecution. Each day of violation constitutes a separate offense.

Also, provided that enough evidence is present to suggest that any damage was caused by the violation of this ordinance, the person in violation shall also be responsible for the repayment to the Town of Liberty for costs associated with repairing any road damage.

3. EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance shall become effective upon its passage and publication as required pursuant to law.

4. SEVERABILITY

If any provision of this ordinance is invalid or unconstitutional, or if the application of this ordinance to any person or circumstance is invalid or unconstitutional, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the provisions or applications of this ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provision or application.
