

ORDINANCE NO L050812

ORDINANCE TO REGULATE PARKING OF VEHICLES

The Town Board of the Town of Liberty, Outagamie County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under s. 349.13, Wis. Stats., to adopt this ordinance.

This ordinance, adapted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, provides for the regulation of no parking of vehicles on town highways in the town as follows:

- A. The parking of vehicles is prohibited on Allcan Road near the entrance of the Department of Natural Resources parking area where Allcan Road turns from North to West.
- B. The town chairperson, or his or her designee, shall place appropriate traffic signs on Allcan Road where parking is prohibited
- C. No persons may park any vehicle on Allcan Road between the "No Parking" signs. Any violation shall be subject to a forfeiture of \$ 25.00.

This ordinance is effective this 9th day of May, 2012.

The Town clerk shall properly post this ordinance as required under s 60.80. Wis. Stats.

This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and posting as provided by law.
